

# Guess who?

## Instructions:

### Version One

- Print out a character sheet for each student. Students will also need paper to write down their chosen character
- Divide students into pairs
- Using the character sheets each student should choose which character they want to be and secretly write that down.
- The aim of the game is for their partner to guess which character they are. To do this students should take it turns to ask each other a question about how they look e.g. 你有黑色头发吗? /你戴帽子吗?
- The questions should be a yes or no question, but they should be answered in a full sentence e.g. 你是男人吗? - 是, 我是男人。
- Once a student has enough clues about their partner's appearance they can guess which character they are.
- The first to guess correctly wins!

### Version Two

- For this version each group will need a set of character cards cut up individually as well as one complete copy of the character sheet.
- Divide students into pairs/small groups
- One student should pick a random a card from the pack and place it on their forehead (this student should not see which character they have picked). They should also have the complete character sheet in front of them as a reference.
- Other students in the groups must then describe the person on the card that has been picked. They should keep describing the character until the student with the card guesses correctly.


